DETERMINE QUORUM; CALL TO ORDER.

The Boards of Directors of Harris County Improvement District Number Six and Harris County Improvement District Number Eleven held a joint meeting, on Wednesday, February 24, 2010, at 12:00 Noon in the 1st floor meeting room of Freed-Montrose Library, 4100 Montrose, Houston TX 77006, inside the boundaries of the District, open to the public, and Chairman Wynn of Harris County Improvement District Number Eleven called the meeting to order at 12:15 p.m., and the roll was called of the duly appointed members of the two Boards, to-wit:

Also present at the meeting were Susan Hill, Josh Hawes and Gretchen Larson of Hawes Hill Calderon, L.L. P.; Clark Lord, Vinson and Elkins, L.L.P.; Mark Burton and Darrell Hawthorne, Municipal Accounts & Consulting, L.L.P.; Pat Hall, Equitax, Inc.; Virginia Blake, McCall Gibson Swedlund Barfoot, PLLC; and Steve Flippo, Anvil Bar and Refuge.

RECEIVE PUBLIC COMMENTS.

Guests at the meeting introduced themselves including Ms. Virginia Blake, Mr. Steve Flippo and Mr. Darrell Hawthorne. There were no public comments.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES OF PREVIOUS MEETING.

a. East Montrose Management District meeting held January 20, 2010 Upon a motion duly made by Director Hubbard and being seconded by Director Fricke, the Board voted unanimously to approve the minutes of the January 20, 2010 Board meeting.

b. Harris County Improvement District Number Eleven meeting held January 27, 2010

Upon a motion duly made by Director Jara and being seconded by Director Robinson, the Board voted unanimously to approve the minutes of the January 27, 2010 Board meeting.

RECEIVE AND CONSIDER EAST MONTROSE DISTRICT MONTHLY FINANCIAL REPORT AND PAY INVOICES.

Mr. Burton welcomed Mr. Hawthorne, who then reviewed the financials included in the Board packets for Harris County Improvement District Number Six. He also distributed the "Harris County Improvement District Number Six Bookkeeper's Report," dated February 24, 2010, hereby attached as Exhibit A. Upon a motion duly made by Director Robinson and being seconded by Director Ueckert, the Board voted unanimously to accept the financial report and pay bills.

RECEIVE MONTHLY EAST MONTROSE DISTRICT ASSESSMENT COLLECTION REPORT AND BILLING AND ASSESSMENT SUMMARY, LAWSUIT AND ARBITRATION STATUS DETAIL, AND DELINOUENT ASSESSMENT REPORT.

Ms. Hall addressed the Board and reported that 83% of the 2010 assessments for Harris County Improvement District Number Six have been collected to date. She said this percentage is similar to the percentage that had been collected at the same time last year. She noted that several lawsuits have been settled with regards to disputed property assessment values. She referred to the detailed delinquent attorney's report included in the Board packets. She said that once a settlement is reached on a property value, the property owner has 21 days during which to pay the assessment, after which penalties and interest begin to accrue. Mr. Lord explained the supplemental appraisal rolls process for adding new properties annually. No action was taken.

CONSIDER ENGAGEMENT OF MARK M. BURTON, PLLC TO PREPARE END-OF-YEAR FINANCIAL REPORTS IN PREPARATION FOR AUDIT OF EAST MONTROSE DISTRICT.

Ms. Hill stated that this agenda item was included by mistake. The Board has already designated Mr. Burton's firm to perform this service. No action was required.

CONSIDER ENGAGEMENT OF MCCALL GIBSON SWEDLUND BARFOOT PLLC TO CONDUCT EAST MONTROSE DISTRICT FY 2009 AUDIT.

Ms. Blake addressed the Board and distributed the engagement letter along with a letter and questionnaire explaining auditing standards relating to fraud, hereby attached as Exhibit B.

Upon a motion duly made by Director Hubbard and being seconded by Director Manning, the Board voted unanimously to engage the services of the auditor for the FY 2009 audit.

APPROVE FISCAL YEAR 2010 EAST MONTROSE DISTRICT BUDGET.

Ms. Hill presented the proposed FY 2010 budget and provided an overview of the categories and budget line items. She said that revenues in the amount of \$433,000 from assessments are anticipated. The budget also includes anticipated revenue from interest and penalties, as well as carry-over funds from FY 2009, for a total estimated budget of \$521,349. Ms. Larson briefed the Board regarding the status of work currently underway on the District's website and logo relating to the business development budget.

There was discussion about classification of the legal fees that have been incurred for the creation of both of the management districts, as well as anticipated legal services and fees for FY 2010 for the East Montrose District. Mr. Lord indicated that his firm will itemize the legal expenses for each District so that the budget will reflect accurate expenditures. Ms. Hill noted that project management and administration expenses are being increased by six percent. She added that expenditures for bookkeeping services may need to be increased by approximately \$1,200 due to preparation of year-end financials by a CPA firm. She said she would have to check with Mr. Hawes to see if he had included this amount in his calculations. Upon a motion duly made by Director Fricke and being seconded by Director Robinson, the Board voted unanimously to approve the FY 2010 District budget with adjustments to be included as discussed.

RECEIVE REPORT AND CONSIDER RECOMMENDATIONS FROM EAST MONTROSE DISTRICT SECURITY AND PUBLIC SAFETY COMMITTEE REPORT WITH REGARD TO THE FOLLOWING

- a. Receive Public Safety Patrol Report for the month of January
- b. Consider funding purchase of in-vehicle radio
- c. Consider funding extended patrol shifts
- d. Discuss First Montrose Commons Security Forum

Mr. Hawes reported that the Committee met February 13. He highlighted the patrol shift reports and said that several arrests have been made during shifts on which two officers are in the patrol vehicle. He said that Officer Victor Becerra, the District's HPD liaison, has requested that a police radio be installed in the patrol vehicle and also that the Committee recommends approving funding for an additional 16 hours per week of patrol shifts. Upon a motion duly made by Director Hubbard and being seconded by Director Fricke, the Board voted unanimously to approve funding for the purchase of an in-vehicle radio and funding for extended patrol shifts. Mr. Hawes also reported on the First Montrose Commons Security Forum, which he said was well-attended.

RECEIVE REPORT AND CONSIDER RECOMMENDATIONS FROM EAST MONTROSE DISTRICT TRANSPORTATION COMMITTEE REPORT WITH REGARD TO THE FOLLOWING:

a. Consider approval of the Walter P. Moore Transportation Inventory

Director Wynn reported that the Transportation Inventory has been completed and is being presented for Board approval. He said the Inventory is an impressive amount of data and includes details such as area sidewalks, street lights and potholes. He noted that the Inventory will be useful for future planning purposes, as well as for contact with the City regarding

maintenance needs. Upon a motion duly made by Director Robinson and being seconded by Director Ueckert, the Board voted unanimously to approve the Walter P. Moore Transportation Inventory.

RECEIVE REPORT AND CONSIDER RECOMMENDATIONS FROM EAST MONTROSE BUSINESS DEVELOPMENT COMMITTEE REPORT WITH REGARD TO THE FOLLOWING:

- a. Receive update on District logo design
- b. Receive update of District website redesign
- c. Receive update on creation of Festival Subcommittee

Ms. Larson briefed the Board and noted that the Buffalo Bayou Coalition may be interested in partnering with the District in regards to a "Keep Montrose Clean and Green" Campaign. She said the Business Development Committee may form a subcommittee to work on planning for a revitalized West Fest. No action was taken.

RECEIVE REPORT WITH REGARD TO THE ESTABLISHMENT AND ORGANIZATION OF WEST MONTROSE DISTRICT


Chairman Wynn reported that the petition process is well underway. He noted that there are several businesses being targeted for signing petitions. No action was taken.





Economic Development

New logos have been received from the graphic artist based upon the committee comments and suggestions from the last meeting and will be distributed to the committee members in advance of our next meeting on April 14.

Work continues on the remaining website pages and we anticipate completion to be March 31. We are also working with a graphic artist on new formatting for the future newsletters and brochures. Staff also met with Crime Stoppers staff to collaborate with them on ways to incorporate the County anti-graffiti campaign with our abatement and education efforts.

Working with the **Houston Business Journal** staff to provide statistical information on the district for inclusion in their listing of management districts in Houston. Also, connected with their staff at the HBJ Radio Makers Show which airs on 950 AM each Saturday morning about the Executive Director participating in a future interview.

Visited with the several RE agents in the area to discuss area development and properties in the district.

The Greater Houston Partnership economic development advisory committee meets this quarter. The new chairman has been selected for the committee, Jason Few with Reliant Energy who will speak to the team tomorrow and share with us his vision for the next year. Also attended several events hosted by HP to promote the district.

The GHP has also requested that staff submit an article for their upcoming "Green" issue as a part of the United Management Districts of Houston partnership. Staff will provide information accordingly.

New board members will receive an outline this week of services from the GHP and a listing of committees on which they can serve.

Met the Executive Director and Marketing and Community Outreach Director of the Red Cross on services and support in the area during times of emergency.

Economic Development Director (EDD) completed the last year of classes to sit for a Planning and Community Economic Development Certification (PCeD). Courses included marketing, PR, lobbying, strategic planning and delivering effective community services. We are eligible to sit for the test in August.

Provided assistance, as needed, to the Director of Services in support of district goals.

Staff will be attending a summer internship programming event at Rice University on April 21. The university is interested in assisting their students with securing real world internships as a part of their required curriculum for graduation.

Working with Executive Director on overall strategic planning related to our participation in the GHP d the United Management Districts of Houston. The UMDofH will be featured in the next edition of

Opportunity Houston magazine due out in May related to "green initiatives" within the districts. Staff ill be serving on the Headquarters Relocation and Business Retention and Expansion Sub-Committees for the GHP.

A sign that things may be turning around, even slightly, is the fact there were several RFI's (leads) issued from the State which were distributed to the broker/owner/agent listing.

Worked on numerous editions and changes for the website.

Exploring various databases to expand the search functionalities and capabilities of our current GIS system. Also, met with several vendors who offer real estate listing services which we may wish to use in the real estate section of the website which is currently under design.

Created a district services brochure for the Meet and Greet on April 12 and followed up with requests for information.

The Business and Economic Development Committee met on April 14 to receive reports and updates regarding the logo development and progress on the website refurbishment. 


