Determine quorum; call to order.

The Boards of Directors of Harris County Improvement District Number Six and Harris County Improvement District Number Eleven held a joint meeting, on Wednesday, June 23, 2010, at 12:00 Noon in the 1st floor meeting room of Freed-Montrose Library, 4100 Montrose, Houston TX 77006, inside the boundaries of the District, open to the public, and Chairman Grover of Harris County Improvement District Number Six called the meeting to order at 12:12 p.m., and the roll was called of the duly appointed members of the two Boards, to-wit:

P.; Clark Lord, Vinson and Elkins, L.L.P.; Darrell Hawthorne, Municipal Accounts & Consulting, L.L.P.; Pat Hall, Equitax, Inc.; Joseph Ellis, McCall Gibson Swedlund Barfoot, P.L.L.C.; Tawanna Stewart, Houston Apartment Association; Jason Pitzel, CoreLogic SafeRent; and Emily Todd, The Menil Collection.

Receive public comments.

Meeting guests introduced themselves.

Approval of minutes of previous meeting:

East Montrose Management District meeting held April 28, 2010

Upon a motion duly made by Director Hubbard and being seconded by Director Ueckert, the Board voted unanimously to approve the minutes of the April 28, 2010 Board meeting.

Receive and consider East Montrose District's monthly financial report and pay invoices.

Mr. Hawthorne reviewed the financials included in the Board packets for Harris County Improvement District Number Six. Upon a motion duly made by Director Hubbard and being seconded by Director Fricke, the Board voted unanimously to approve the financial report and pay invoices.

Receive East Montrose District's monthly Assessment Collection Report and Billing and Assessment Summary, Lawsuit and Arbitration Status Detail, and Delinquent Assessment Report

Ms. Hall addressed the Board and reported that 87% of the 2010 assessments for Harris County Improvement District Number Six have been collected to date. She noted that effective July 1, 2010, all delinquent assessment payers will incur additional 20% penalties. She also said that 2010 Harris County commercial property values are an average of 11% lower than last year.

a. Consider request for waiver of penalty and interest with regard to a real property accounts suit filed 11/6/09 against Torres Commercial Real Estate Trust 2007-08 assessments.

Ms. Hall explained that Torres Commercial Real Estate Trust requested a waiver of penalty and interest on its 2007-08 assessments. The Trust claimed it had not received notice of the assessments due to an incorrect mailing address and later paid its assessments in full. Hall indicated that another delinquent assessment payer has recently made a similar request for a waiver of interest and penalties. Ms. Hall said she would check with the mortgage company of the second assessment payer. Mr. Lord said that the Board follows strict tax codes and assessment orders. No action was taken.

Adopt Capitalization and Depreciation Policy for East Montrose Management District.

Mr. Hawes explained that the policy is being re-adopted for accounting purposes. Upon a motion duly made by Director Hubbard and being seconded by Director Fricke, the Board voted unanimously to adopt a Capitalization and Depreciation Policy for the East Montrose Management District.

Consider proposals for renewal of East Montrose Management District's insurance policies; take appropriate action.

Mr. Hawes said that the renewal date is August 1, 2010, and that staff recommends obtaining insurance through the Texas Municipal League Intergovernmental Risk Pool. Upon a motion duly made by Director Hubbard and being seconded by Director Ueckert, the Board voted unanimously to renew the East Montrose Management District's insurance policies through the Texas Municipal League Intergovernmental Risk Pool.

Approve East Montrose District FY2009 Audit Report.

Mr. Ellis addressed the Board and presented a "Revised Draft 2009 Annual Financial Report," dated June 23, 2010, hereby attached as Exhibit A. He reviewed the Report. Upon a motion duly made by Director Hubbard and being seconded by Director Robinson, the Board voted unanimously to approve the East Montrose District FY 2009 Audit Report.

Receive and consider report from East Montrose District's Public Safety Committee with regard to the following:

a. Patrol Activity Report for the months of April and May 2010.

Mr. Hawes provided the Board with an overview of patrol activities for April and May, 2010.

b. Consider contract with ASE Security for three mobile security cameras.

The Board reviewed the contract proposal from ASE Security for three mobile security cameras including monthly camera rental costs and installation costs. Mr. Lord said if the contract is operable on a month-to-month basis and if there are no detailed terms and conditions, he would recommend approval. Following discussion, and upon a motion duly made by Director Hubbard and being seconded by Director Robinson, the Board voted unanimously to approve the contract with ASE Security for three mobile security cameras with the stipulations that were discussed by legal counsel.

c. Consider funding the purchase of a Netbook.

Mr. Hawes presented the pricing from Verizon Wireless for a Netbook purchase and monthly DSL line charges. Board members requested additional pricing from other suppliers. Upon a motion duly made by Director Hubbard and being seconded by Director Robinson, the Board voted unanimously to table the agenda item regarding a Netbook purchase until competitive pricing is obtained.

Receive and consider report from East Montrose District's Visual Improvements Committee with regard to the following:

a. District-wide Master Plan

Director Fricke reported that he and Mr. Hawes met and discussed the District's Master Plan. Mr. Hawes reported that staff has been approached with regards to a new Museum District Pedestrian/Transit Master Plan. The Museum District has commissioned the Plan to become more pedestrian-friendly as part of a Federal initiative for sustainability and livability. It was noted that it is part of a collaborative effort between the Federal Transit Administration and U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development and that The Goodman Corporation, a firm specializing in the planning, financing and implementation of mobility projects, has been retained to do the planning. No action was taken.

Receive report from East Montrose District's Business Development Committee;

Ms. Larson reported that logo designs are in the process of being developed and that work is also well underway on the District's website, www.montrosedistrict.org. She said that the committee recommends dissolving its West Fest subcommittee and instead focusing on a business development event that will feature the uniqueness of the Montrose area, such as its many chef-owned restaurants. She said meetings are currently underway with possible strategic partners for the "Clean and Green" Campaign. No action was taken.

Receive report with regard to the establishment and organization of HCID #11;

Mr. Hawes reported that the petition process is still underway. He noted that there are 19 signed petitions and that several businesses are being targeted. No action was taken.

Receive Executive Director's Monthly Report on Action Initiatives in Support of the District's Service Plan.

Mr. Hawes said that the action initiatives have been discussed during the meeting. No action was taken.

There being no further business to come before Harris County Improvement District Number Six, Chairman Grover yielded the floor to Vice Chairman Mitchmore of Harris County Improvement District Number Eleven to conduct business.

On behalf of Keep Houston Safe PAC, Wilson Research Strategies, a national public opinion research firm, conducted a research study of likely voters in Houston, Texas.

The results indicate that nearly all voters in Houston are aware of Intersection Safety Cameras (also known as "Red Light" Cameras) and that a clear majority of Houston voters support Safety Cameras and their continued use in Houston.

Key Observations

1.) Nearly all likely voters in Houston are familiar with Intersection Safety Cameras

- Nearly half (48%) of likely voters report having seen, read, or heard "a lot" about Intersection Safety Cameras with another third (36%) saying "just some."
- Fewer than one in six (15%) voters report having heard not too much or nothing about Intersection Safety Cameras.

2.) Highly likely Houston voters overwhelmingly support the use of Intersection Safety Cameras in Houston

- Two in three (65%) voters support Intersection Safety Cameras, while only one in three (33%) opposes them.
- Furthermore, almost half of likely voters "strongly" support the devices (45%). Only 2% of respondents did not give an opinion.

3.) Support for Intersection Safety Cameras cuts across political, racial, and socioeconomic lines

- At least six in ten voters of all racial groups support Intersection Safety Cameras
 - o 65% of Whites:
 - o 67% of Hispanics; and
 - o 60% of African-Americans support the Intersection Safety Cameras.
- Republicans, Independents, and Democrats all support Intersection Safety Cameras, as do voters who self-identify as conservative, moderate, and liberal.
 - 58% of Republicans;
 - o 73% of Independents; and
 - 62% of Democrats support the devices.
 - 59% of conservatives;
 - o 72% of moderates; and
 - 66% of liberals support the cameras.



- Voters of all socioeconomic groups support Intersection Safety Cameras, though support is slightly higher with more educated voters.
 - o 63% of voters earning under \$80,000 a year; and
 - o 69% of voters earning more than \$80,000 a year support Intersection Safety Cameras.
 - o 69% of voters with a college degree;
 - o 65% of voters who have completed some college; and
 - o 55% of voters with a high school diploma support Intersection Safety Cameras.
- 4.) Voters showed an overwhelming degree of support for Intersection Safety Cameras and the benefits they bring the Houston community.
 - o 77% of voters were convinced that Intersection Safety Cameras are a reasonable response to people who run red-lights.
 - o 74% of voters were convinced that it is helpful that Intersection Safety Cameras have the ability to record the date, time, location and speed of the vehicles they photograph to ensure the accuracy of tickets.
 - o 71% of voters were convinced that Intersection Safety Cameras make Houston safer.
 - 60% of voters were convinced that Intersection Safety Cameras help to free-up police officers so they can focus on catching dangerous criminals.

5.) Voters indicated that yellow light standards are important.

80% of voters believed that every intersection should be reviewed to make sure that there are clear standards dictating how long a yellow light should last in order to improve the intersection safety cameras.

Conclusions

Houston voters are overwhelmingly supportive of Intersection Safety Cameras. The vast majority of Houston voters are aware of the cameras and approve of the City of Houston's use of them. While there are some differences in support among demographic groups, majorities of all political, racial, and socioeconomic groups support Intersection Safety Cameras.

It is clear that Houston voters have reached an informed decision about Intersection Safety Cameras and believe that they are a worthwhile means for the city to effectively monitor traffic violations.

Methodology

Wilson Research Strategies, a national public opinion research firm, conducted a research study of likely voters in Houston, Texas.

WRS selected a random sample of likely voters from the Texas voter file using Registration Based Sampling (RBS). RBS is an innovative method of stratifying samples based on a set of demographic and behavioral characteristics. The sample for this survey was stratified based on geography, age, gender, and ethnicity. This methodology avoids post-survey "weighting" which can reduce the reliability of survey results.

Respondents were contacted by phone via a live telephone operator interview March 1-2, 2010. The study has a sample size of n=500 likely General Election voters. The margin of error is equal to $\pm 4.38\%$ in 95 out of 100 cases. The live operator maximizes the response percentage in order to minimize bias associated with low incidence rates.




