She said that public notices have been mailed for the upcoming public hearing set for October 21, 2010 on the creation of HCID #11 and are being mailed for the upcoming supplemental assessment roll public hearing set for November 4, 2010 for HCID #6. No action was taken.

## Receive Executive Director's Monthly Report on Action Initiatives in Support of the District's Service Plan.






